The show hall is Heated as needed. The show hall is accessible. It is a NON-smoking facility. NO Alcohol is allowed in the show hall. Entries are limited to 149. Per CFA Rules; Entries close Monday, January 5 2025 at 8:59 pm Pacific time, or when 149 entries have been received!

Recommended Airport: The Show Hall is approx. 40 minutes from the Sacramento Int'l Airport (SMF).

Show Rules: The show will be conducted in accordance with current CFA show rules. These may be obtained online at <https://cfa.org/wp-content/uploads/2025/04/25-26show-rules.pdf> or send \$7.00 plus \$2.00 postage to CFA, 260 East Main Street, Alliance, OH 4460. All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with a Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Owners of novices can contact the entry clerk for a temporary registration number. Rosettes and Ribbons will be awarded according to CFA show rules. No kitten under the age of four months will be allowed in the show hall. Blue slips may be required for proof of age.

Entries: Per CFA rules, only cats registered with either a permanent or temporary Registration number are eligible for entry in the Kitten, Championship and Premiership categories and the Veterans, Provisional Breed, Miscellaneous (Non-Competitive) or AOV Classes. All entries must be submitted via the main eCats CFA entry portal at <https://ecat.cfa.org/Login?>

CFA rules state that entry fees must be paid within 10 days after receiving entry confirmation. Make checks or money orders payable in U.S. funds to "CFA Northwest Region". **Pay** at the door is not available for this show. Please ensure your payment arrives on time. There will be a \$15.00 late fee charged if payment is not made or postmarked on or before January 4th. **Paypal is available at Catfannregion@gmail.com**

Health: No veterinary inspection will be required prior to benching. It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in" the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formally know as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), rhinotracheitis, & calici viruses. California State law requires current rabies vaccination. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. Front and back claws must be clipped before Benching. Declawed cats are not eligible for entry. All cats are expected to be free of fleas, mites and infectious illness.

Household Pets: Household pets are eligible only for awards in the Household Pet Class. Household pets are to be judged separately from all other cats, solely on beauty and condition. Wild cats or wild cat-domestic hybrid crosses are not eligible for entry. All Household Pets eight (8) months of age or older must be spayed or neutered.

Cages: A single Bench space of 22" x 24" is provided with each entry. A Groom space is 44" x 24". You may purchase an extra (double) bench space for a single entry @\$20. No more than one adult or two kittens per single bench space. Per state law, No grooming tables can be placed in the aisles. Please bring your own cage. ~~A limited number of wire cage rentals (\$15.00) or pop-up items will be available to purchase for \$25.00/ea. These both require a double bench space. Contact the entry clerk to pre-order pop-up if needed.~~

Check-In & Show Hours: Check-in time will be 7:00 to 8:00 am. U.C. Davis Speakers at 8:00 am. Judging starts at 9:30 am Sharp! Advertised Show hours are from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm. One benching request per exhibitor will be honored whenever possible. No benching changes are permitted without the permission of the show manager.

Food & Litter: litter will be provided. Please bring your cat's preferred food as well as dishes and litter pans. No onsite food. There will be a food truck on site between 11:00 am and 3:00 pm.
