SHOW HALL: San Berenardino County Fairgrounds. 114700 7th Street, Victorville, CA 92395. The show hall has heat/AC as needed and is handicap accessible, with free parking adjacent to, and on the same level as, the show hall. No alcoholic beverages or smoking in or near the show hall allowed. Las Vegas Cat Club will not be responsible for damage, loss, personal injury, or loss of property. The club reserves the right to add or change judges.

CHECK-IN HOURS: 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. Saturday. Any entry not checked in by 8:30 a.m. will be marked absent. Judging will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday. Advertised show hours are from 10:00am to 5:00pm Saturday. All exhibitors are expected to be present during advertised show hours unless given permission to leave early by the show manager.

HEALTH: It is strongly advised that all cats or kittens entered or present in the show hall be inoculated before entry by a licensed veterinarian against feline panleukopenia (formerly known as feline distemper or feline infectious enteritis), feline rhinotracheitis, calicivirus and rabies. It is also strongly recommended that cats and kittens be tested and found negative for FeLV before entry. All claws of each entry must be clipped prior to benching. Failure to do so will subject the entry to disqualification. Declawed cats are not eligible for competition. All kittens must be four months of age on or before the first day of the show.

CFA SHOW RULES: will govern this show. A copy of the show rules can be purchased from CFA, Inc., 260 East Main St., Alliance, OH 44601 or found on the CFA website at cfa.org. Rosettes will be awarded for all final wins. Permanent flats will be used, but ribbons will be available at the owner's request. The club reserves the right to add or change judges.

SCORING: All entries in Championship (except Novice), Premiership (except Novice), registered Kittens, recorded Household Pets, and registered cats competing as Household Pets with an Household Pet color class prefix will be scored for CFA awards. Owners of cats/kittens without registration numbers can contact the entry clerk for a Temporary Registration Number.

BENCHING REQUESTS: will be limited to one exhibitor and will be honored when possible. No negative benching requests please. *End of row benching requests will be honored as available, with the fee waived for disabled exhibitors.

AMENITIES: Litter will be provided, but please bring your own litter pans. It is also suggested that you bring your own food and water bowls. Cage spaces are the standard DOUBLE size cages normally used outside region 5. A single cage space is 21" wide by 30" deep. A double cage space is 45" wide by 30" deep. You are responsible to bring your own benching cage. None will be provided at the show. If you have your own region 5 cage you will need to purchase a groom space.

NEW EXHIBITORS: should bring a towel or rug for the floor of the cage and enough fabric to go around and cover the top of the cage. ALL CATS MUST BE BROUGHT IN A CARRIER. Declawed cats are not eligible for entry.

ENTRIES AND FEES: Make checks payable to LAS VEGAS CAT CLUB. Bounced checks will incur a \$50 fee. PayPal is available using the "Friends & Family" option at: lasvegascatclub@gmail.com. Anyone not using "Friends & Family" will be charged PayPal fees at the door. Each entry must be submitted online. For entry clarification, the entry clerk will call collect. Entry fees must be received within 10 days of submitting an entry. THE SHOW IS ACCEPTING ENTRIES NOW!

FOOD: People food will be available at the show hall. Grand Parties are welcome inside the show hall benching area.

AIRPORT: The nearest airport is the Ontario International Airport (ONT).
